### Listening: A Framework for Teaching Across Differences ...

Generally, they will focus on developing the ability to listen for the main idea first with a task that focuses on getting the gist of the audio clip before playing the clip a second time with a new task that focuses on more detail or specific information of the clip. After receiving input from a listening source, at the end of the lesson, the students will get practice with output (i.e. with a speaking and/or writing activity).

### Listening Lessons - Learn, Teach, Travel.

The Framework for Teaching describes those aspects of a teacher's practice that have been demonstrated, through both empirical and theoretical studies, to promote student learning. It divides the complex work of teaching into four major domains—planning and preparation, the classroom environment, instruction, and professional responsibilities—each of which contains five or six smaller components (see fig. 1).

Receptive skill lessons (reading and listening ones) follow the same framework while productive skill ones follow two different frameworks (one focusing on speaking and the other on writing). Below are summaries of each of the lesson stages with links (just click the relevant headings) to a detailed description of each one including examples and video demonstrations.

### Lesson Frameworks - Learn, Teach, Travel.

Earlier views of listening saw it as the mastery of discrete skills or microskills, such as recognizing reduced forms of words, recognizing cohesive devices in texts, and identifying key words in a text, and that these skills should form the focus of teaching.

### Teaching Listening and Speaking: From Theory to Practice

The framework for a speaking lesson is the same as the writing lesson above, but the model text is listening rather than reading. The model suggests preparing content first rather than language. I'd say these stages are interchangeable, as they are above too.
